

Since college, she developed as a multi-sport athlete as a member of the Air Force Triathlon team. With her family's encouragement, French began dedicated training for Modern Pentathlon in 2018. Since then she steadily climbed USA rankings and began to compete internationally in 2021. Her aspirations include sustaining top a national ranking, enhancing her world ranking and earning a spot on the 2024 USA Olympic team.
